- ◆ Demonstrate proper use of the cardiac monitor and defibrillator in a variety of case scenarios for ACLS emergencies

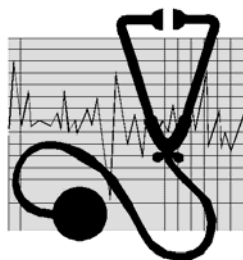
